

# Waste to worms: making landfill the last resort

Following the successful launch of the Repair Café, the second initiative under the WasteSorted project funded by the Waste Authority, is all about tackling food waste.

The Shire of Bridgetown-Greenbushes, in partnership with Ashbil Community Garden, is encouraging our community to try worm farming - a simple yet effective way to reduce food waste and keep it out of landfill. We've designed a range of opportunities to support you, whether in person or online to help build your knowledge around transforming food scraps into a nutrient-rich fertilizer for your garden.

As part of this initiative, we're offering four workshops at the Ashbil Community Garden presented by Ann Bentley from Beaufortia Environmental. These sessions will cover everything you need to know about worm farming, including what food items can and cannot be added, how to set up a system, and tips for maintaining it effectively.

In addition to the workshops, we will be developing additional resources, including:

A "How to Worm Farm" video for those unable to attend in person. This will focus on using recycled materials to create a worm farm at home and will be available on the Shire website for easy access.

A program of online content throughout the year, highlighting the benefits of worm farming, simple ways to reduce food waste, and celebrating success stories from our community.

In line with the grant's goal of prioritising reuse and making landfill the last resort, we're repurposing 60 old kerbside bins into functional worm farms. Attendees of our in-person workshops will receive one of these worm farm systems free of charge! ... Continued on page 15



# **Bridgetown Historical Society**

The Southern Forests and Valleys Heritage Festival 2025 takes place between Saturday 19 April and Sunday 4 May throughout many towns in the South West.

Here in Bridgetown the Police Station 1880 Museum will have free entry to the Museum from Monday 21April – Saturday 26 April. This building is of important historical significance to Bridgetown and the Museum is curated by the BHS.

Tenders for a new police station located in the centre of town were called for in 1879, and the building was completed by James Gibbs in October 1880 – it was built for a total of £423. Constable Bovell moved into the new premises on 18 October 1880, which at the time had living quarters for the Police... Continued on page 14

Transition Bridgetown Waging War on Waste.

The war against waste continues in Bridgetown led by our community's tireless champions of sustainability, Transition Bridgetown.

The Uniting Church Hall was the venue for an engaging discussion on reducing waste on February 23, when Michael Coghill spoke on the challenges of eliminating e-waste, something he's been pursuing through his business Total Green Recycling since 2008.

In a well-attended Open Space the Shire's Sustainability and Environmental Officer Alexa Tunmer updated the community on our joint Shire/TBR initiative to start up a series of Repair Cafes. This project is supported by the State Government and the Waste Authority, encouraging repair and reuse over disposal to landfill.

The Waste Warriors updated us on their plans and progress on rethinking waste as a resource. This was followed by a vibrant Q&A where our community brainstormed ideas.

The first Repair Café will be held at the Lesser Hall 10am till 2pm on Sat March 8th. Please call in while you're in town

voting, enjoy a cuppa and find out more.

It's all part of Transition Bridgetown's ambitions to reduce waste in our community, which is something we'll be putting into practice again at this year's Blackwood Regen Fest on Saturday 22nd of March at the Ashbil Community Garden. You'll find the Regen Fest a great celebration of education, inspiration and fun, with free workshops sharing knowledge on regenerative practices. There's something for everyone at the Regen Fest, with farm animal displays, a vintage clothes market, gourmet food and coffee and more. Please find the advertisement for Regen Fest '25 elsewhere in this edition of the Mailbag.

Speaking of the Ashbil Community Garden, Transition Bridgetown is looking forward to hearing progress on its Lotterywest funding application for a shed onsite. It will house our Wash Against Waste Trailer and provide shelter for Bridgetown Community Landcare Nursery volunteers. One thing that's already been approved, thanks to a generous grant from Talison, is a rainwater tank for the shed.

Transition Bridgetown's committee voted to introduce an annual membership fee of \$20 per person per annum at the AGM last year. As from the end of Feb, non-members will be asked for a \$5 entry donation at Open Space events to help with hall hire and insurances. Financial members will have free entry.

# A Step Ahead for Dalgarup

After a worrying two weeks in discussion with Solicitors for the large Mining Exploration Claim over the Greater Dalgarup Forest (Dalgarup National Park, the Bridgetown Jarrah Park and the Karri Gully Nature Reserve), the Mining Company has proposed a 6 month deferment of this claim, to allow time for further negotiation.

This provides a time slot during which we can seek to have the classifications of the two reserves updated AND the Nunn Block included into the National Park.


The two reserves would then be substantially protected if the Exploration Claim was approved. Last night the Shire Council resolved to accept our Petition to seek Government support to protect Greater Dalgarup Forest against Mining. This has been signed by 610 local residents. An Officer proposal for action will be prepared for consideration by the March meeting of the Council.
